



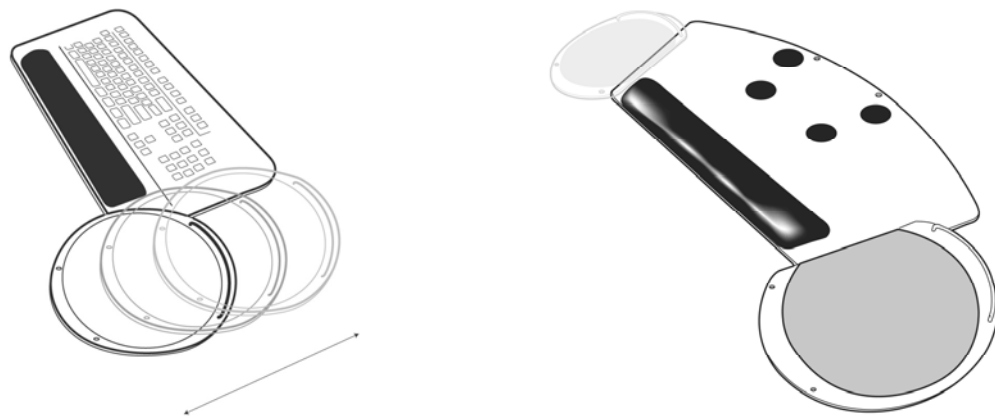

1. Attach the Keyboard Tray to the Articulating Arm with hardware provided (4 machine screws and 4 bolts).

2. The Mouse tray simply slides onto the left or right side of keyboard tray. It is supposed to have a tight fit, however,

- a) If mouse tray does not attach firmly, tighten screws on the underside of the mouse tray clockwise until preferred fit is achieved.
- b) If mouse tray fits too tight, loosen bolts on the underside of the mouse tray counterclockwise until preferred fit is achieved.

You can position the mouse tray anywhere along the left or right edge of keyboard tray.

3. The gel or memory foam palm rest is attached with velcro. This allows the user to adjust the position along the front edge of the keyboard tray (which may be necessary if the mouse tray is moved from the right to the left side).

4. The non-skid pads are used to hold the keyboard in place. They can be attached to the keyboard tray surface or the bottom of the keyboard itself.

5. The wire mouse catcher keeps the mouse from falling off the tray. The mouse cord runs under the bar. It can be moved to the opposite side if the mouse tray is switched from right to left.
